MAGICA: A new project to fast-track the sharing of cutting-edge climate research

MAGICA – maximising the synergy of European research governance and innovation for climate action - is an exciting collaborative project across the European Research Area (ERA). The partnership brings together 24 leading climate change research and boundary organizations from 13 European countries, in a four-year transnational project.

MAGICA is funded by Horizon Europe and initiated and realised by JPI Climate. Its objective is to accelerate the development, provision and exchange of knowledge from research and innovation to inform and support policy-making and climate actions via better coordination of on-going and future initiatives and more efficient use of resources. MAGICA is also responsible for hosting flagship events that drive informed dialogue on climate action (see more about MAGICA events below).

MAGICA brings the influential European Climate Change Adaptation Conference to Ireland for the first time. Focusing on six critical climate themes, the 6th ECCA is sub-titled 'Actionable Knowledge for a Climate Resilient Europe'.

The audience will be adaptation experts - researchers and practitioners, policy-makers, local authorities, the private sector with a focus on businesses already engaged and taking action on climate risk, investors, NGOs, citizens organisations, youth and education organisations, community groups engaged in adaptation, communicators and all interested individuals. They will hear from Europe's leading climate researchers who are using trusted data to develop novel climate action tools, decision-support platforms and prototype climate services.
