1st Equinox Summit
Held on 21st - 22nd March, 2023, Brussels, Belgium

The Equinox Summit – the first European climate change science summit - took place in March. Organised by JPI Climate and MAGICA in support of the European Commission, it brought together 12 European Research and Climate and Environment Ministries represented by Ministers, State Secretaries and/or mandated senior officials. They signed a joint statement committing to establishing a process to determine how to accelerate the transfer of knowledge from science and innovation to climate policy and actions.
