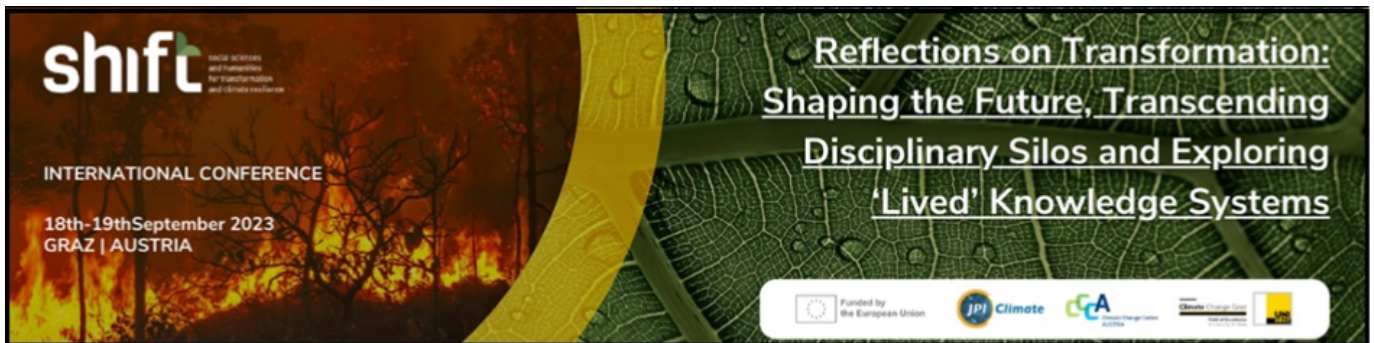

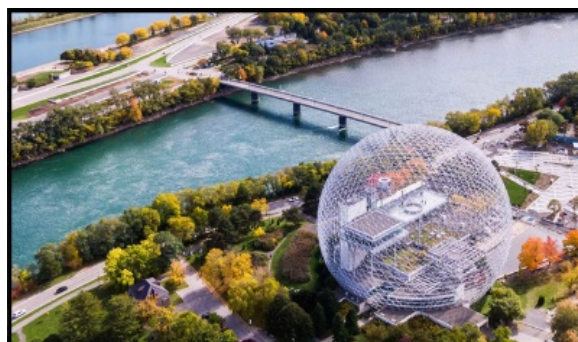


MAGICA General Assembly and JPI Climate Governing Board Meeting

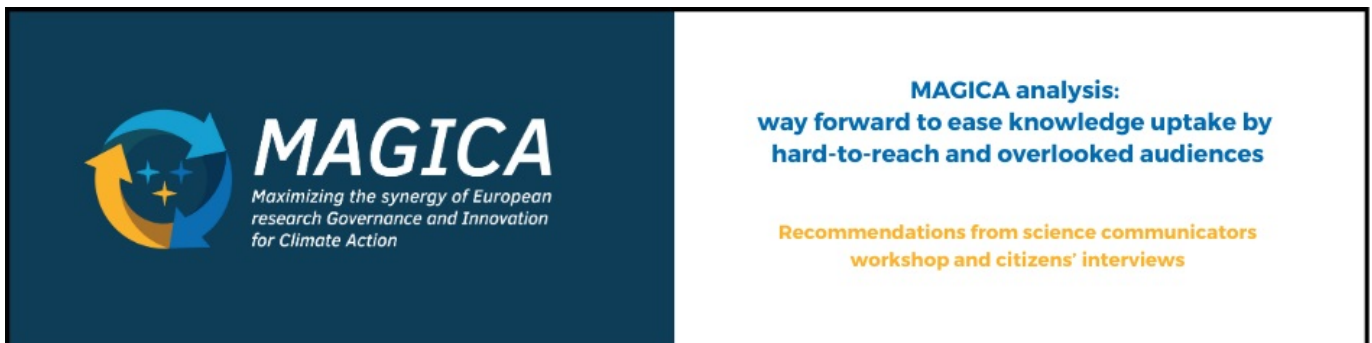
